

Part-Time Operators

Department: Operations
Reports to: Operations Lead Hand, Manager of Operations
Job Type: Seasonal Part time
Hours: **Must be available to work nights, weekends and occasional day shifts**

Summary:

In this position you are a member of the operations team. Duties required working with operations personnel to ensure that all events are a success as they relate to the operations department.

Primary responsibilities

- Assist full time operations personnel in maintenance, repairs, and improvements of all arena equipment as it relates to the department
- Support operations team with event changeovers, Ice rink maintenance, Arena HVAC maintenance, ice refrigeration maintenance and computers that control HVAC, ice refrigeration, lighting, scoreboard and office PC's
- Remove rink glass and dasher boards for event set-ups when needed.
- Set up and tear down folding chairs, staging and risers when needed.
- Reinstall arena glass before returning to hockey setup
- Reinstall dasher boards exits as needed
- Winter / Snow Removal: Shovel off, salt and sand all sidewalks, stairs, landings, exits and entrances
- Must wear CSA approved hockey helmet any time walking on the ice surface.
- Other duties as assigned.

Requirements:

- Any labor experience is an asset
- MUST have CSA approved steel toe work boots.
- Ability to do heavy lifting and carry up to 75 pounds.
- Demonstrate familiarity with tools and maintenance equipment.
- Ability to work with limited supervision and as a team member
- Ability to work varied schedule including evenings, overnights and weekends.

Working Conditions:

- Work requires significant physical effort, walking (including stairs), and lifting heavy weights.
- Work requires utilizing tools and equipment that could cause physical injury if not handled and operated following safety practices and procedures. Required to follow WHMIS and provincial Health and Safety requirements.

Ice Crew

Summary:

In this position you are a member of the operations team. Duties require maintaining the ice surface/ice equipment. Any event-oriented preparation/setup required for shows or sporting events to run safely and efficiently, other duties as assigned.

Primary responsibilities:

- Operate and maintain Zamboni as directed by the head ice maintenance technician
- Keep floors around loading dock and hall ways clean and dry
- Repair and clean all hockey glass, glass posts, dashers, bench areas, and any other equipment associated with the rink
- Perform all pre-game and post-game duties as assigned
- Roll out carpets for special presentations
- Bring out game nets and put away practice nets and at end of games
- Inspect ice surface for damage and inform head ice technician of any unsatisfactory conditions
- Inspect nets for damage and repair
- Shovel and scrape excess snow and ice off of ice after Zamboni leaves ice surface
- Setup/breakdown tables, chairs, pipe & drape, and any other equipment as assigned by supervisor
- Winter / Snow Removal: may be asked to shovel off, salt and sand all sidewalks, stairs, landings, exits and entrances during your assigned work shift
- Other duties as assigned.

Requirements:

- Any ice maintenance experience is an asset
- MUST have CSA approved steel toe work boots.
- Ability to do heavy lifting and carry up to 75 pounds.
- Demonstrate familiarity with tools and maintenance equipment.
- Ability to work with limited supervision and as a team member
