AREA OF RESPONSIBILITY:

- Sets up and services individual beverage locations.
- Enforce all liquor laws.
- Maintain proper sanitation of work area.
- Follow proper safety practices in the work area.
- Provide pleasant and efficient service to customers.
- Prepares all beverage items for sale in the station.
- Sells to customers, charging amount indicated on company price list.
- Receives and handles cash and/or tickets.
- Verify and account for all cash and liquor inventory with supervisor.
- Verifies cash register is programmed properly, according to company approved sales prices.
- Follows Bar Procedures.
- Follows all rules and regulations which apply to the beverage operations and to ASM's Food and Beverage Division.
- Requests identification for every guest purchasing alcohol.
- Perform other duties as assigned based on event needs.

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE

- Minimum high school diploma or GED.
- Previous bartending experience and/or training is preferred.
- Cash handling experience preferred.
- Must be thoroughly familiar with alcohol management procedures.
- Responsible Beverage Service Certificate preferred.
- Hold proper Food handler's certification.
- Ability to function in a fast-paced, team-oriented environment.
- Commitment to exceptional quest service.
- Excellent communication skills.
- Proficiency in English required, proficiency in French preferred.



AVAILABILITY

This position is part-time, primarily evening and weekend shifts. All Food & Beverage scheduling is dependent on the Avenir Centre's events calendar.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS / WORKING CONDITIONS
